**Sub: According Administrative Approval to the Kolachi Lift
Irrigation Scheme (near 36th Km of KRBC) - Reg.**

Letter No.WRD/P&I/TA-4/AE-2/Estimate/2001, Dated:04-08-2003, from the Engineer-in-Chief, Water Resources Development Organisation, Bangalore.

Preamble :-

Kolchi weir in Ramdurg Taluk has a Right Bank Canal running to a length of 49 Kms. with 42 outlets including 27 sub-distributories. About 33 villages with an atchkat of 12,600 acres are coming under this scheme. Beyond 37th Km. of Kolchi Right Bank Canal in the 18 to 27 distributories difficulty is experienced to supply water under these distributories since the canals under Kolchi weir is very old and lost its canal cross sections. An atchkat of about 3950 acres is coming under suffering atchkat in the tail-end of KRBC. About 35 cusecs of water is required to feed this suffering atchkat which has been observed to be available in the Bennihalla from the seepage water of Malaprabha Right Bank Canal and also rain water available during rainy season in Bennihalla. The villages benefitted under this scheme are Asuti, Holemannur, Gadgoli, Hebballi, Menasagi, Holealur, Kurugovinkoppa, Amargol and Hole Hadagali. As per the survey & investigations conducted by the Water Resources Department Organisation, it is proposed to lift water from Bennihalla near Asuti village to feed the tail-end blocks of KRBC under 18 to 27 sub-distributories. About 3950 acres of suffering atchkat under Kolchi weir is proposed to be fed by utilising about 0.30 TMC of water from Bennihalla. 0.30 TMC of water has been allocated towards Kolchi Lift Irrigation Scheme in the revised Master Plan submitted to the Central Water Commission on 15-01-2002.

2. Water Resources Development Organisation, Bangalore, has conducted Survey and Investigations after which a proposal for Rs.225.00 lakhs has been submitted to the Government vide reference above with utilisation of 0.30 TMC of water from Bennihalla river.

3. This proposal has been examined at Government level and hence the following orders:-
